

# Hunter United Website Policy

This Hunter United ("HU") Website Policy applies to your use of the Hunter United Website and the Hunter United Mobile Website (together, "HU Websites") which are operated by Hunter United as a division of IMB Ltd, ABN 92 087 651 974, AFSL/Australian Credit License 237 391 under the domain name hunterunited.com.au. This Website Policy explains how HU collects and uses information when you interact with HU Websites. HU's Privacy Policy covers HU's collection and use of your personal information generally and also applies when you use HU Websites.

## 1. What information is collected?

The information HU collects from you online depends on how you interact with HU Websites. If you fill in an online form – for example a competition entry form or an online application form – HU will collect the information you enter and will store and use this information in accordance with the HU Privacy Policy. This may also be the case where you start filling in an online form but you do not submit it, for example because you choose to save the form for later completion.

HU also collects and securely stores your IP address (a string of numbers that identifies your computer when using the internet) when you log into Internet Banking. HU uses IP addresses to assist in fraud investigation and prevention activities.

Another way that HU collects information from you online is by the use of "cookies".

## 2. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your computer by websites you visit. Cookies record information about how you use a particular website and can be used to help improve your browsing experience by remembering your preferences and providing you with a more personalised experience the next time you visit that website. A new cookie is added to your computer and assigned a random identification number the first time you visit a website. Each time you visit the website after that, the cookie is updated automatically. Cookies do not record personally identifiable information about you but may record your Internet Service Provider (for example, Telstra or iiNet) and the internet browser you are using (for example Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox). Cookies may also collect other information such as the date and time you access a website, how you got to the website and the links you use to navigate around the website.

## 3. How does HU use the information collected using cookies?

HU uses aggregated data collected from cookies to analyse traffic on HU Websites. In addition, we may also transmit website usage data to third party advertising partners to allow them to serve more appropriate, customised banner ads to you on external websites. As noted in point 2, above, please be aware that no data we submit to third party advertising partners is capable of personally identifying you.

## 4. Can I delete cookies from my computer?

Yes – your internet browser will have an option that allows you delete all of the cookies stored on your computer. Please refer to the "Help" section of your browser for information on how to delete cookies from your computer.

## 5. Can I "turn off" cookies on my computer?

Yes – you can configure your internet browser to accept all cookies, reject all cookies or notify you when a website attempts to send a cookie to your computer. Please refer to the "Help" section of your browser for instructions on how to modify the way websites are allowed to place cookies on your computer.

Please be aware however that as most websites, including HU Websites, rely on cookies to deliver full functionality to you, if you set your browser to reject all cookies, you may not be able to make full use of a website's features.

## 6. Data Security

HU takes all reasonable precautions to ensure that the data we collect through HU Websites is kept secure from unauthorised access, misuse or loss. Please see section 8 of HU's Privacy Policy for further information.

## 7. Links to external websites

HU Websites may, from time-to-time, contain links to non-HU websites. Although these links are provided for your benefit, please be aware that these external websites may not have the same data security policies as HU.

## 8. Acceptance of this Website Policy

By using HU Websites, you agree that you have read and accept this Website Policy and, where relevant, HU's Privacy Policy.

## 9. Changes to this Website Policy

This is the current HU Website Policy and it supersedes any previous versions of the HU Website Policy that may have been published on the HU Website. HU may vary this Website Policy from time-to-time and will provide notice by publishing the new version on the HU Website. By continuing to use HU Websites after a new version of this Website Policy has been published, you acknowledge that you have received notice of any changes and accept the new version of the Website Policy.
